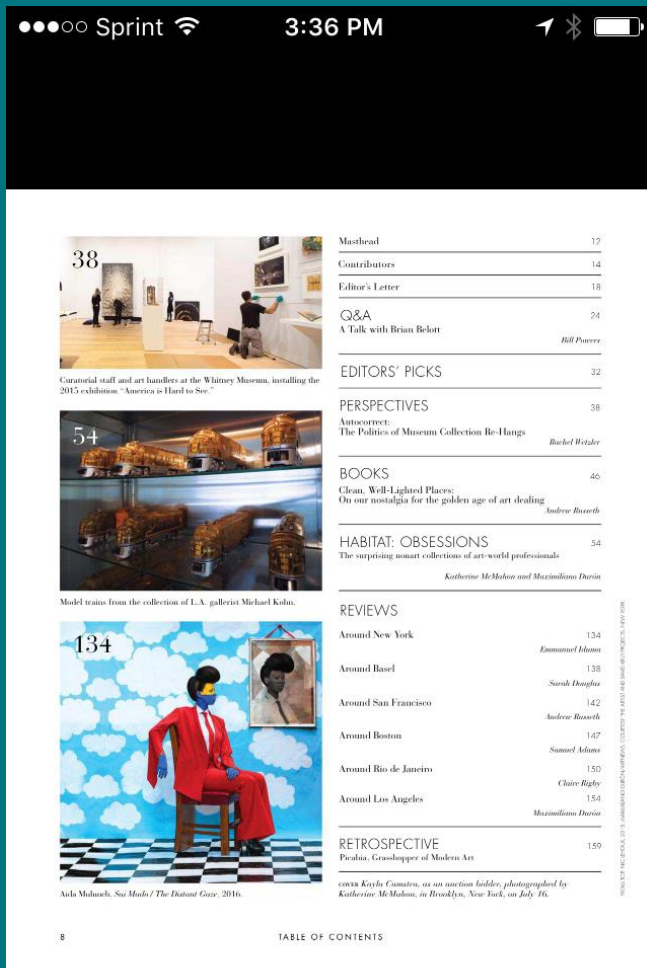


Wi-Fi means magazines will only download when you are connected to wi-fi so not on your data plan.
