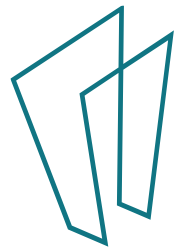


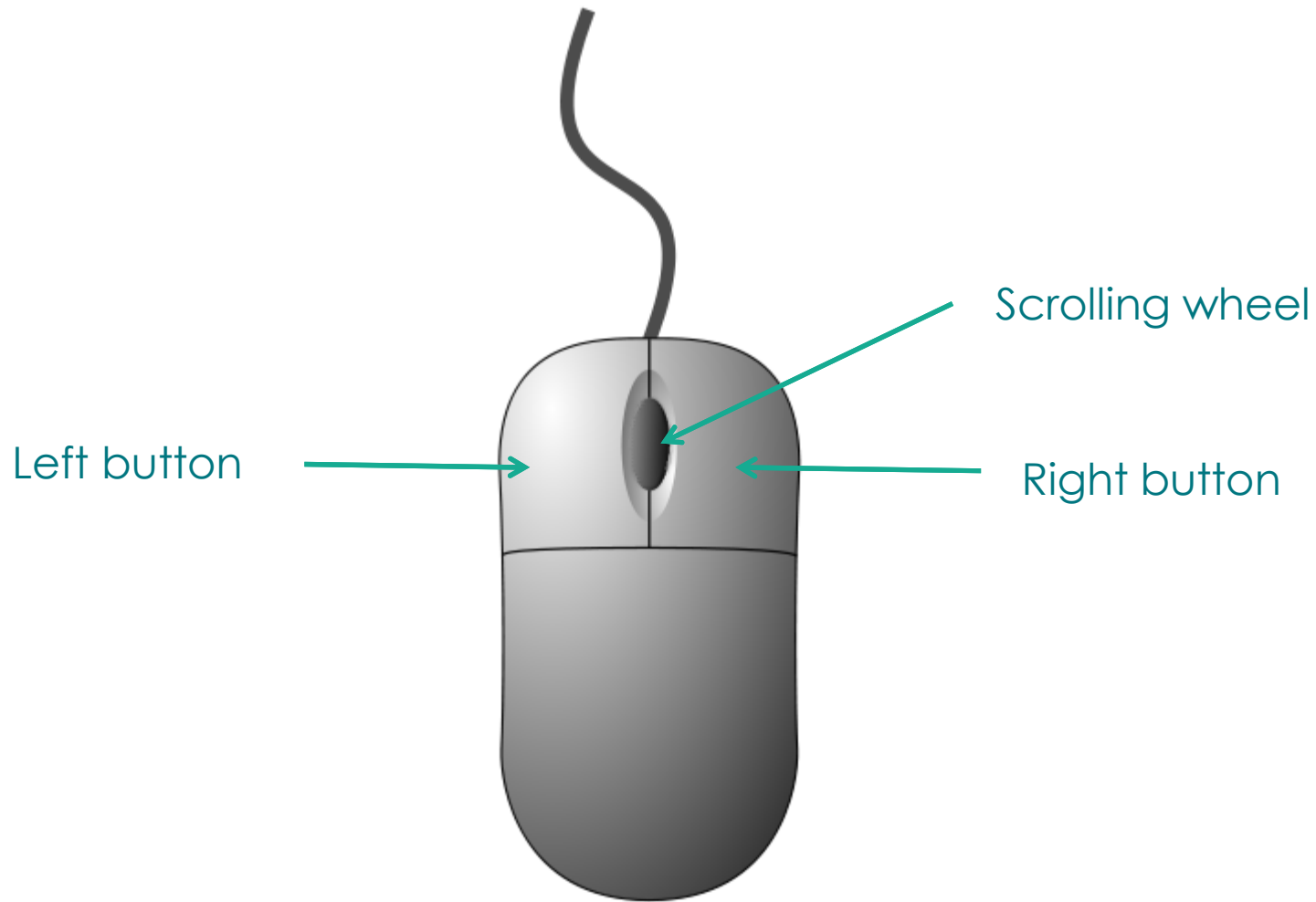


Don't be sacred of the mouse!

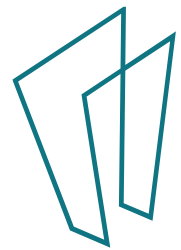


- The mouse is an input device that allows you to interact with the computer.
- Clicking a button on the mouse sends a signal to the computer to trigger an action

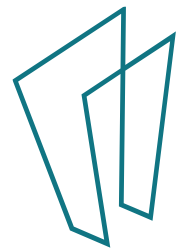




- The left and right buttons are used for clicking
