Mimicry and camouflage are utilized by animals in the wild to help protect them from predators. In this activity you can create your own form of camouflage.

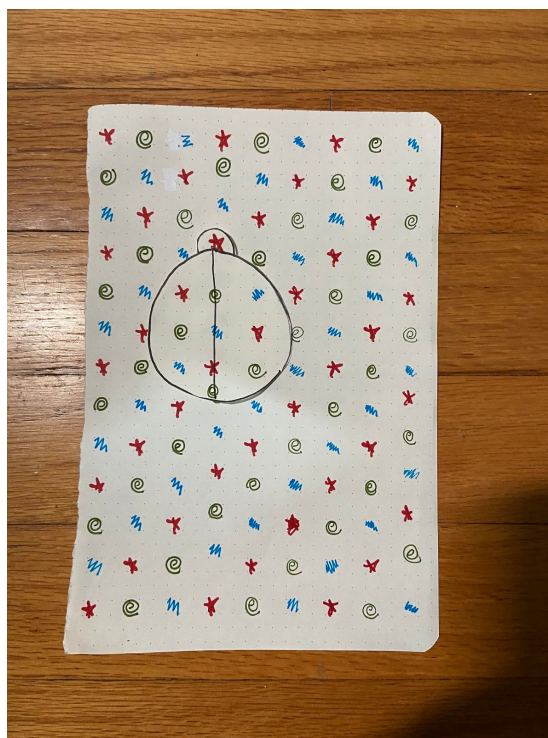
### Supplies

- Piece of paper, plus scratch paper
- Colorful markers
- Cut out of animal or insect

### Instructions

- On a sheet of scratch paper, figure out a repeating pattern that you should like to draw.
- Draw and repeat said pattern on a piece of paper.
- Cut out your animal or insect image and try to match it up with the pattern
- Draw patterns on the animal or insect to match. Try moving it around to see how well it can blend in.
